DRAFT CODIFICATION OF INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION POLICIES

SYMBOL: CAL:LJ

This refers to your memorandum of February 1, 1956 transmitting proposed policy statements for inclusion in the codification of international cooperation policies for the Policy Code.

It is recommended that the draft policy statement be amended in the following particulars:

1. On the first page, last paragraph, change "who have engaged in activity . . ." to read "who have engaged in certain significant activities . . ."
2. That section of the draft dealing with policy toward Yugoslavia should be amended since the policy in these respects has been the subject of a revised directive. The substance of this policy is contained in a recent memorandum from the Chairman to the General Manager. It is suggested that you communicate with Comdr. Charles E. Nelson of the Chairman's office to determine the appropriateness of including a reference to Yugoslavia.

We concur in the inclusion in the Policy Code the draft policy statement relating to byproduct material exports which you forwarded this Division on March 1, 1956.
