Dear Dr. Seaborg,

Thank you for your letter of the 10th July, 1961, in which you confirm the arrangements for the supply of lithium 6.

I note that you are giving consideration to my enquiry regarding the interest of the Atomic Energy Commission in acquiring additional amounts of plutonium. I am now able to amplify the information contained in my letter of the 26th June, 1961*. Although our review is not yet complete, our latest assessment is that we might be able to supply the quantity of one tonne earlier than the date mentioned in my previous letter, namely the end of 1965. It might also be possible to make a rather larger quantity available.
