ORDER

(Regarding Provision of License Amendment Applications)

1. This proceeding involves two applications of Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO), to amend its operating licenses for Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Units 2 and 3, by relocating selected radiological effluent technical specifications (RETS) and associated bases from the licenses at issue to the Millstone Radiological Effluent Monitoring and Offsite Dose Calculation Manual (REMDCM). Petitioners Connecticut Coalition Against Millstone (CCAM) and the STAR Foundation (STAR) have petitioned to intervene and requested a hearing with regard to the amendment applications.

2. In order that the Licensing Board and all participants may better understand and more efficiently address the matters at issue in this proceeding, NNECO is requested to provide copies of the relevant amendment applications and all attachments to the Licensing Board, as well as to provide copies or access to copies of the same to the petitioners' counsel and NRC staff counsel, unless counsel is already in possession of these documents. The documents

should be provided as soon as possible but no later than the close of business on October 2, 2000, in electronic form if possible on October 2, with written mailed copies to follow.

3. After receipt of the staff's answer to the petition, a scheduling order will be entered, setting forth deadlines for filing of appropriate pleadings and stating any relevant issues the Board wishes the participants to address.
