Dear Ms. Riddell:

In an e-mail, dated April 7, 2000, to Chairman Meserve of the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, you expressed your concerns with our use of probabilistic risk assessment techniques to justify the safety of existing spent fuel pool designs. Mr. John A. Zwolinski, Director, Division of Licensing Project Management, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, responded to your e-mail in a letter dated June 9, 2000. In his letter, Mr. Zwolinski stated that your comments would be addressed in our evaluation of public comments associated with the Draft Final Technical Study of Spent Fuel Pool Accident Risk at Decommissioning Nuclear Power Plants, and that we would send you a copy of this document when it was issued. I am writing to inform you that the document has not yet been issued and that the scheduled issue date has shifted from August 2000 to later this year.

As stated in Mr. Zwolinski's letter, we will send you a copy of the technical study, which will include the resolution of public comments, when it is issued.
