The Commission was briefed by Commonwealth Edison Company on the status of their nuclear power plants.

Chairman Jackson noted that Commonwealth Edison has a responsibility to perform better than they have over time and that from a regulatory perspective having the Dresden plant on the NRC's Watch List for six of the last nine years was too long. Chairman Jackson asserted that Commonwealth Edison needed to focus on the management of their activities to bring them up to industry standards.

There were no requirements identified for staff action.
