The Commission¹ was briefed by the General Accounting Office (GAO) on their audit of the SDMP program and by the NRC staff on SDMP program and policy issues. The Commission requested that the staff review the policies for assignment of project managers and develop a management plan to improve the continuity and stability for the SDMP sites. The Commission also requested further information on the possible application of the business process reengineering to the SDMP program.

The staff should provide the Advisory Committee on Nuclear Waste the opportunity to review proposed streamlining of the SDMP program and ensure that input is received from the regulated community.
