Dear Ms. Norry:

Under Executive Order 13149, "Greening the Government Through Federal Fleet and Transportation Efficiency," Federal agencies must ensure that their alternative fueled vehicles (AFV) use alternative fuel at least 50% of the time by 2005. Because many areas have little or no alternative fuel infrastructure, it is important that federal activities maximize the use of alternative fuels where AFV fueling infrastructure is available.

This year, the Navy Exchange Service Command opened an AFV fueling facility offering multiple alternative fuels at its Navy Exchange (NEX) "Quarters K" service station next to the Pentagon. The new alternative fuel pumps provide compressed natural gas (CNG) and ethanol (E-85) (the E-85 pump is currently the only ethanol facility in the mid-Atlantic region). These fuels burn cleaner than conventional petroleum-based fuels.

To support the Executive Order requirement, DoD policy requires that alternative fuels be used in AFVs 100% of the time whenever refueling infrastructure is reasonably available ("reasonably available" is defined as within five miles). We will be using the NEX Quarters "K" facility to help satisfy this requirement.

We invite you to use this new AFV fueling facility as well. NEX Quarters "K" is conveniently located in Arlington, VA, at the intersection of Joyce Street and Columbia Pike just below the Arlington Annex and within view of the Pentagon. This AFV fueling station is open and available for all Federal Government vehicles and is particularly convenient for those operating in or about the downtown Washington, DC, area. A map indicating the location of NEX Quarters "K" is enclosed.




