I. SECY-95-195 - Final Amendments to 10 CFR Parts 20 and 35 on  
Medical Administration of Radiation and Radioactive  
Materials

The Commission (Chairman Jackson, exercising delegated authority pursuant to a delegation from the Commission,<sup>1</sup> in accordance with NRC Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1980) approved final amendments to 10 CFR Parts 20 and 35 to clarify that the medical administration of radiation and radioactive materials to any individual, even an individual not supposed to receive a medical administration, is regulated by the NRC's provisions governing the medical use of byproduct material rather than by the dose limits in the NRC's regulations concerning standards for protection against radiation.

The Federal Register notice should be reviewed by the Rules Review and Directives Branch, ADM, and returned to the Secretary for signature and publication.

II. SECY-95-218 - General Atomics' Motion for Housekeeping Stay of Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's August 21, 1995 Order Ruling on Intervenor's Motion to Compel Answers to Interrogatories

The Commission (Chairman Jackson, exercising delegated authority pursuant to a delegation from the Commission,<sup>2</sup> in accordance with NRC Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1980) approved an order granting a temporary housekeeping stay to give the parties an opportunity to file petitions for a full stay, to provide General Atomics time to file a petition for Commission review, and to provide the Commission time to consider the merits of a full stay.
