By letter L-2000-177 dated September 8, 2000, Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) applied for the renewal of the Operating Licenses for Turkey Point Units 3 and 4, pursuant to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) regulations set forth in 10 CFR 50, 51 and 54. An original and thirteen copies of the Turkey Point Units 3 and 4 Application for Renewed Operating Licenses (Application) were provided to the NRC. The original and each copy of the Application included an environmental report entitled "Applicant's Environmental Report - Operating License Renewal Stage." In addition, one copy of the Application was provided to the NRC Regional Administrator - Region II and one courtesy copy of the Application was provided to the NRC Senior Resident Inspector for Turkey Point. Twenty-six additional copies of the Applicant's Environmental Report - Operating License Renewal Stage were also provided. All copies discussed above were paper copies.

By letter dated October 4, 2000, the NRC notified FPL that the Application previously submitted contains sufficient information that is acceptable for docketing. Additionally, in response to FPL letter L-2000-169 dated August 8, 2000, the NRC notified FPL by letter dated September 21, 2000 that the additional copies of the Application required for docketing may be provided in electronic form as Compact Disks - Read Only Memory (CDs). Accordingly, additional copies of the Application (including the Applicant's Environmental Report - Operating License Renewal Stage) are being provided on CDs as described below.

Per 10 CFR 2.101(a)(3), 50.4(b)(2), 50.30(a), and 51.55(a), twenty-five (25) additional CD copies of the Application are enclosed. One (1) CD copy of the Application is being provided to the NRC Senior Resident for Turkey Point, one (1) CD copy of the Application to the NRC Regional Administrator - Region II, and one (1) CD copy of the Application to each of the following: Florida




