NRC EMERGENCY TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM,
DATED JUNE 30, 2000.

Dear Sir/Madam:

This letter is being issued to provide AmerGen's written commitment to participate in the Optional ETS methodology as requested in Regulatory Issue Summary 2000-11, NRC Emergency Telecommunications System, dated June 30, 2000.

AmerGen will perform the following work to conform to the NRC guidelines for replacing the FTS2000. This work is voluntary and will be performed at the following sites:

- Three Mile Island
- Oyster Creek

By December 6, 2000, each of the above listed sites will convert the existing FTS 2000 circuits to regular PBX extensions that are supported by the PBX that is dedicated for each site. Each telephone will be labeled with the new 800 numbers that will be provided by the NRC.

The only exception to this will be circuits that service the control rooms at Oyster Creek and Three Mile Island. The FTS 2000 circuits will be migrated to the FTS 2001 system, which will provide service to both control rooms from separate Central Office switching locations. AmerGen's Emergency Preparedness organization will update their procedures to reflect these changes.

Once this information is known, these numbers will be supplied to the NRC ETS Project Manager in a subsequent communication as specified in the RIS 2000-11 Response Guideline.
