The Commission was briefed by the NRC staff on the status of reactor pressure vessels in commercial nuclear power plants. Additional information was requested on the potential use of materials from pressure vessels at permanently shutdown reactors as a source of samples. The Commission also requested that it be kept informed of the discussions with industry about the public release of vessel test data which are considered proprietary in some cases.
