SUBJECT: DOSE ASSESSMENT FOR THE MOLYCORP, WASHINGTON,
DECOMMISSIONING PLAN, PART 2

Dear Mr. Dawes:

On July 14, 2000, you submitted Part 2 of your decommissioning plan (DP) for the Molycorp, Washington, PA, facility. This DP proposes the on site disposal of all radioactive waste resulting from decommissioning. On September 15, 2000, you informed us of your plans to dispose of above ground waste off site and concluded that this activity is currently authorized by your license. In a letter dated September 18, 2000, we agreed with this conclusion. The removal of this waste will significantly reduce the source term for the dose assessment associated with the disposal cell. Because the dose assessment is related to the level of institutional controls required, we request that you inform us of your plans and schedule for revising the DP.
