I am responding to your letter to Mr. John Greeves, dated September 7, 2000, which stated that neither the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection nor the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will act as a third party beneficiary for the Molycorp, Washington, PA, site.

As discussed in your letter, we will begin our review of Molycorp's Washington Facility Decommissioning Plan (DP), Part 2, dated July 14, 2000, with an evaluation of its proposed institutional controls (IC) and financial assurance (FA) provisions. Our initial request for information, which will cover the IC/FA portions of the DP, will address your position. As you are aware, we are in the process of scheduling a meeting with you and your staff to discuss our plans for conducting an integrated review of the entire DP.
