I. SECY-93-037 - Environmental and Resources Conservation
Organization's Appeal of LBP-93-23 (Rancho Seco)

The Commission, by a 5-0 vote, approved an order which responds to an appeal by the Environmental and Resources Conservation Organization (ECO) of LBP-92-23 which denied ECO's petition for intervention and a hearing on the Rancho Seco decommissioning proceeding. The order to a limited extent grants ECO's appeal. The order notes that the Commission has withheld a final decision on ECO's petition and has remanded the matter to the Licensing Board for a determination on the admissibility of any amended or new contention filed in accordance with the terms of the order.
