SUBJECT: STAFF REQUIREMENTS - DISCUSSION ON FULL POWER

PUBLIC ATTENDANCE)

The Commission was briefed by representatives from several public interest groups, the licensee, and the NRC staff on the issuance of a full power operating license for Comanche Peak (Unit 2).

The Commission requested further information on the following specific items:

1. the proposed license exemption for criticality monitoring,
2. licensee use of a computer-based configuration management system,
3. the specific cable ampacity derating values and existing margins, and
4. clarification on requirements for laboratories that perform fire protection tests and how such requirements are determined to be met.
