

Subject: Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station Security Plan, Security Personnel Training and Qualification Plan, and Safeguards Contingency Plan, Revisions 47 and 48

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.4(b)(4), "Security plan and related submittals," and 10 CFR 50.54, "Conditions of Licenses," paragraph (p)(2), attached are the original and three (3) copies of the Commonwealth Edison (ComEd) Company Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station Security Plan, Security Personnel Training and Qualification Plan, and Safeguards Contingency Plan, Revisions 47 and 48.

Revisions 47 and 48 include the following changes.

- A clarification was added to the "bullet resistant" definition to include the minimum height specification from Underwriters Laboratories Standards for Safety, Bullet Resisting Equipment - UL 752. This clarification is consistent with NUREG-0908, "Acceptance Criteria for the Evaluation of Nuclear Power Reactor Security Plans."
- Access controls were enhanced by adding a requirement to secure Control Room ventilation ductwork access ports.
- Security Personnel Training and Qualification Plan: several word, title, and reference changes resulting from ComEd's revised Training and Qualification Plan.
- Safeguards Contingency Plan: several reference changes resulting from ComEd's implementation of new Security operating procedures.
- Other changes have been made that are considered "editorial" in nature. These changes affect terms and titles that are no longer applicable and do not decrease the overall level of security system performance.

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As required by 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2), we have concluded that these changes do not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station Security Plan, Security Personnel Training and Qualification Plan, and Safeguards Contingency Plan.

These changes to the Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station Security Plan, Security Personnel Training and Qualification Plan, and Safeguards Contingency Plan were implemented on May 12, 2000, for Revision 47 and June 13, 2000, for Revision 48. In accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2), these changes shall be reported within 60 days of implementation, i.e., July 11, 2000, and August 14, 2000.

Attachment 2 contains Safeguards Information that must be protected from public disclosure as required by 10 CFR 73.21, "Requirements for the protection of safeguards information."
