Dear Mr. Meehan:

I am responding to the October 6, 2000, letter from Congressman Meehan to Dennis K. Rathbun, regarding a letter from Congressman Meehan's constituent, Mr. Jay Pallis. Mr. Pallis is concerned that his company, DS Graphics, is incorrectly listed in the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Licensing Tracking System (LTS) database as a user of radioactive material.

We have reviewed our records and confirmed that DS Graphics is not listed in the LTS. However, there is a listing for Engineering Dynamics Corporation (EDC), 120 Stedman Street, Lowell, MA, which is at the same street address as DS Graphics. EDC, who apparently was a former occupant of this location, had an NRC license. However, EDC never received nor possessed radioactive material. Its license expired on May 31, 1987.

Enclosed are inspection records that confirm that the EDC license is expired and the case was closed out, based on a determination that no radioactive material was ever present at the 120 Stedman Street location. Mr. Pallis may use these records to document that the Stedman Street location was previously occupied by an NRC licensee, but that there are currently no radioactive materials at the site.
