
Dear Freedom of Information Act Officer:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552 et seq, I hereby request a copy of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's evaluation of the financial condition of the United States Enrichment Corporation (USEC), including a summary paper prepared by the NRC staff (SECY-00-0181) and an additional report prepared by IFC Consulting.

In your letter on this evaluation to Chairman Bliley of September 11, 2000, you note possible sanctions under the Trade Secrets Act as a reason to limit public release of this NRC evaluation. If possible sanctions under the Trade Secrets Act are indeed an issue, please redact those specific items that are legitimately proprietary and not available elsewhere. It should be noted that it would be considered a Freedom of Information Act violation to deprive the public of all of the information in this report, especially where not all information is derived from proprietary information that has not been made public already.
