Subject: ADAMS RETROFIT OF LICENSING FILES

On September 26, 2000 the NRC Executive Council met to approve continued progress on retrofits to ADAMS Libraries. In particular they approved two years of retrofitting Reactor License Case Files and Reactor Technical Specifications.

Available (i.e., Executive Council approved) funding for these two years provides for adding approximately two-thirds of the case and tech spec files to ADAMS. The remaining third would, presumably, be added in a yet unfunded (i.e., requiring another \$700k) third year. The rate of addition is approximately 7 reactor case and tech spec files every three months. The Executive Counsel briefing also indicated that FSARs will not be included in ADAMS.
