
ORDER NO. 3

On October 2, 2000, the Campaign for Ratepayer's Rights [CRR] Filed a Motion to Intervene [Motion] in this proceeding. In the Motion, CRR committed to adhere to the existing procedural schedule, including the existing schedule for filing testimony.

Counsel for CRR was admitted as a party from the outset of this docket and, as CRR's Motion notes, he has been furnished with all filings and orders. Further, CRR has been an active participant in prior proceedings and will be represented by able counsel, which mitigates the need for delay due to the intervention of CRR. Finally, no party has objected to the Motion.

Therefore, pursuant to Nuclear Decommissioning Financing Committee Rule Dec 204.03, the Motion to intervene of the Campaign for Ratepayers' Rights is granted.


