Gentlemen:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 30 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-50 for the Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit No. 1. The amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications in response to your application dated August 23, 1975, as supplemented by your letters of September 15 and October 19, 1976, and March 9, 1977.

This amendment requires operability and surveillance of shock suppressors (snubbers) required to protect the primary coolant system and all other safety related systems and components. We have made certain changes in the Technical Specifications you proposed and have discussed these changes with your staff.

A copy of the Federal Register Notice is enclosed. A copy of the Safety Evaluation relating to this amendment was included as part of our letter of February 17, 1977.
