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Gentlemen:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 22 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-50 for the Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit No. 1. The amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications in response to requests Nos. 33.2 and 33.3 contained in your letter dated June 3, 1976, as amended through staff discussions.

This amendment revises the provisions in the Technical Specifications relating to anomalous measurements of environmental radiological levels and associated reporting requirements. These changes do not alter the effectiveness of the program nor do they result in any changes from the standpoint of radiological impact.

These changes do not involve significant new safety information of a type not considered by a previous Commission safety review of the facility. They do not involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident, do not involve a significant decrease in a safety margin, and therefore do not involve a significant hazards consideration. We have also concluded that there is reasonable assurance that the health and safety of the public will not be endangered by this action, nor will it be inimical to the common defense and security.

Copies of the Environmental Impact Appraisal and the Federal Register Notice are also enclosed.
