SUBJECT: SECY-92-005 - REGULATORY IMPACT SURVEY FOR
FUEL CYCLE AND MATERIALS LICENSEES

Based on the information provided by the staff, the Commission did not agree with the staff's conclusion that a regulatory impact survey of fuel cycle and major materials should not be conducted. Therefore, the staff should prepare a proposal for a regulatory impact survey which addresses fuel cycle and materials licensees and submit it to the Commission. The proposal should discuss the proposed size of the survey, including whether to include medical licensees, and the resource limitations and impact on competing staff priorities. The Commission will defer a decision on proceeding until the staff proposal is submitted.
