



On September 23, 1981, the Commission issued Amendment No. 74 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-50 for Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit No. 1 (TMI-1). The amendment revised the license and Technical Specifications to reflect that GPU Nuclear Corporation is to replace Metropolitan Edison Company as the licensee authorized to operate TMI-1. This license amendment was to be effective upon a date approved by the NRC following receipt of appropriate documentation that the requirements of the Securities and Exchange Commission, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, State of New Jersey Department of Energy, Board of Public Utilities, and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission have been met.

By your letter dated December 16, 1981, you requested that the effective date of transfer to GPU Nuclear Corporation as the licensed operator of TMI-1 be January 1, 1982. Your letter also referenced the approvals of the above listed agencies authorizing the formation of GPU Nuclear Corporation.

Based on our review of your December 16, 1981 letter and the referenced approvals by the Securities and Exchange Commission, Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission, New Jersey Department of Energy, Board of Public Utilities and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, we hereby approve your request for establishing January 1, 1982 as the effective date of transfer to GPU Nuclear Corporation as the licensed operator of TMI-1. Accordingly, January 1, 1982 is established as the effective date of Amendment No. 74 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-50.
