The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 65 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-50 for Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit No. 1 (TMI-1). The amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications in response to your request dated March 31, 1980 (TLL 141, TSCR No. 90), and staff discussions.

The amendment revises the Technical Specifications for TMI-1 to establish a modified surveillance requirement for the reactor internal vent valves by extending the present surveillance interval to the completion of the 5th fuel cycle.
