This letter responds to your August 8, 1984 request for immediate implementation of Amendment No. 78 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-50 for Three Mile Island Nuclear Station Unit No. 1 (TMI-1). The Amendment, issued on October 20, 1982, revises the Technical Specifications for TMI-1 to incorporate certain of the TMI-2 Lessons Learned Category "A" requirements and other short-term requirements identified in the Commission Order of August 9, 1979.

Amendment No. 78 was stated to become effective as follows:

"Unless the Commission modifies conditions of the Licensing Board's Partial Initial Decision dated December 14, 1981, which would affect this action, this license amendment becomes effective 60 days after the Commission accepts the Board's recommendations as set forth in that Decision, or restart, whichever is earlier."

In Commission Decision CLI-84-11 dated July 26, 1984, the Commission has addressed the plant design and procedures in the TMI-1 restart procedures and in the staff's opinion, has accepted the Board's recommendations that affect Amendment No. 78. Accordingly, Amendment No. 78 became effective 60 days after the July 26, 1984 decision date, that is, Amendment No. 78 became effective on September 24, 1984.
