Comments: I was upset to learn that the NRC is considering a "generic" 20-year extension on the life of nuclear power plants rather than decommissioning them, under the current regulatory regime.

I was also unhappy to see that the NRC scheduled a single public hearing and a fairly short period for public comment. Is public safety being jeopardized by the lobbying dollars of the utilities? It certainly looks that way.

I am writing to urge the NRC to extend the period for public comment, and to schedule a full round of hearings in the areas that will be affected by these licence extensions. I would appreciate a reply from the Commission with either a rationale for the current hearing and comment schedule, or notification of a change in the Commissions hearing and comment plans for this issue.
