Comments: I request that you extend the public comment period for the proposed decision to extend license renewals rather than institute decommissioning. The decision to do this seems to have been made with little regard for public opinion, and does not look to have been done with any attempt to gain public comment.

Such behavior seems like it could easily be interpreted as sneaky and fearful. It is also dubiously legal at best. Evading public comment is not the right way to operate any agency in the United States...it angers the people, and enough anger produces instability. While minimal public comment periods may follow the letter of the law, they miss the spirit of the law altogether.

Please extend the public comment period, and release information regarding this decision, and the issues around it, to the public. Once that is done, real and constructive commentary can be made.
