Comments: I am completely opposed to a generic 20-year extension on the life of our nation's nuclear reactors. Nuclear reactors were not designed to work indefinitely and I feel it is very unsafe and a danger to the health and wellbeing of the American public to automatically ask the nuclear plants to work beyond what was initially intended and for that amount of time for which the plants were originally licensed.
