The Commission, by a 5-0 vote,* approved an order which denies the staff petition for review of a December 13, 1991 Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Order in which the Board denied the staff's request for clarification or reconsideration of certain issues.

* Section 201 of the Energy Reorganization Act, 42 U.S.C. §5841, provides that action of the Commission shall be determined by a "majority vote of the members present." The Chairman and Commissioner Remick, however, had previously indicated that they would approve this paper and had they been present they would have affirmed their prior vote.
