Subject: Amendment to Import License Number IW008

Dear Mr. Hauber:

Starmet CMI (CMI) requests, under 10CFR110.51, an amendment to NRC License Number IW008 for import of additional radioactive depleted uranium materials to our Barnwell, South Carolina facility. Specifically, Starmet CMI requests that NRC License Number IW008 be amended as follows:

- Increase the quantity of depleted uranium metal and oxide in the form of machined swarf/turnings and solid pieces from 80,000 kilograms to 250,000 kilograms.
- Increase the quantity of mineral oil from 45,000 liters to 240,000 liters.
- Add AEA Technology, also located in the United Kingdom, as an additional supplier of depleted uranium swarf/turnings and solid pieces. AEA Technology has contracted Starmet CMI to recycle their depleted uranium materials. The material will be shipped from AEA Technology's Harwell facility.
- Shipments are scheduled to begin in January of 2001 and be completed by August 24, 2004.
- The material will be transported by ship to Savannah, Georgia.

All other conditions remain unchanged.
