

SURVEILLANCE REQUIREMENTS

ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel  
Code and applicable Addenda  
terminology for inservice  
inspection and testing activities

Required frequencies for  
performing inservice  
inspection and testing  
activities

Weekly  
Monthly  
Quarterly or every 3 months  
Semiannually or every 6 months  
Every 9 months  
Yearly or annually

At least once per 7 days  
At least once per 31 days  
At least once per 92 days  
At least once per 184 days  
At least once per 276 days  
At least once per 366 days.

- c. The provision of Specification 4.0.2 are applicable to the above required frequencies for performing inservice inspection and testing activities.
- d. Performance of the above inservice inspection and testing activities shall be in addition to other specified Surveillance Requirements.
- e. Nothing in the ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code shall be construed to supersede the requirements of any Technical Specification.
