Subject: Re: Proposed release of low level radioactive materials from regulatory standards.

I am in full agreement with Diane D'Arrigo of Nuclear Information and Resource Service, and I take issue with the NRC's plan to release low level radioactive materials from regulatory standards. We must ISOLATE radioactive materials and prevent exposures, not deliberately expose people by allowing radioactive materials into regular daily commerce, or into their yards and gardens, or into agriculturally productive fields. If soil and materials are contaminated from nuclear power and the fuel chain, then it should be treated as a waste and isolated.

Please consider the greater good before an easy fix, or profit. The proposal to release low level radioactive materials from regulatory standards is a very dangerous one, and should not be allowed.
