Reactor Vessel Integrity Database Update Schedule**

In letter L-99-127 dated August 17, 1999, to the NRC, it was indicated that the information for the update of the NRC Reactor Vessel Integrity Database (RVID) would be sent to the NRC within six months of the removal of the surveillance capsules from the respective vessels.

FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company (FENOC) will provide the NRC with the surveillance capsule evaluation information within one year of the capsule removal date as required by Appendix H of 10 CFR 50. The RVID update will be transmitted to the NRC within the same time frame as the surveillance capsule evaluation (under separate cover letter).

FENOC expects to submit the surveillance capsule evaluation and the RVID update information to the NRC by March 8, 2001 for Unit 1 (capsule removed March 8, 2000), and October 8, 2001 for Unit 2 (capsule removed October 8, 2000).
