SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION (OI 4-2000-031A)

Dear Mr. Ray:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC Office of Investigations (OI) regarding activities at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS). OI initiated the investigation to determine whether a contract radiation protection technician was the subject of employment discrimination for reporting safety concerns to SONGS management.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegation was not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action regarding this investigation and considers this case closed.
