We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) correspondence dated October 4, 2000, transmitting the FEMA final exercise report for the June 6 - 7, 2000, emergency preparedness exercise at the Palisades Nuclear Generating Plant.

No deficiencies were identified by FEMA regarding the performances of State and county officials. Two areas requiring corrective action were identified by FEMA staff for the State of Michigan and two areas requiring corrective action for Allegan County.

We fully recognize that any corrective actions to be implemented may involve parties and political institutions which are not under your direct control. Nonetheless, we expect that assistance, if appropriate, will be extended.
