The Commission¹ was briefed by the NRC staff on NRC activities regarding nuclear safety and safeguards in the former Soviet Union and Eastern Europe.

The Commission requested further information in three specific areas:

- 1) How has the break-up of the Soviet Union affected their participation in WANO?
- 2) What is the current status of the nuclear power plants being constructed in Cuba?
- 3) What is the NRC doing to encourage, and assist in, establishing or strengthening nuclear regulatory bodies and processes in the former Soviet Union and Eastern Europe?
