Thank you for your response of November 10, 2000, to our Notice of Violation issued on July 17, 2000, concerning activities conducted at your Nuclear Test Reactor facility. We have evaluated your response and found that it meets the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201. We will examine the implementation of your corrective action during future inspections.

We noted that you did not receive NRC Inspection Report 50-73/2000-201 in a timely manner due to an error on our part regarding the correct address for your facility. Thus, your response to the Notice of Violation was delayed but was submitted within the required 30-day period after you received the Inspection Report. The problem with the address has been corrected.
