Re: Draft NUREG-1725 "Human Interaction With Re-Used Soil: A Literature Search"

Radioactive soils should not be released or recycled in any way. They should be isolated from the public and the environment.

It is our understanding that the purpose of your Commission is to protect the public from radioactive contamination. It doesn't make sense to us that you would even consider releasing radioactively contaminated soil from regulatory control. It is irresponsible to continue to pollute the environment and endanger our lives with radioactivity. There are no "acceptable doses" of radiation. You should not lump us together and say that it won't harm us...we are individuals...do not assume that radiation is ok for everyone. We live within 10 miles of a nuclear power plant and are continually contaminated by radioactive emissions - please do not add to our health risk by deregulating radioactive materials and wastes which will allow recycling of this waste into daily commerce as if it were not contaminated.
