I understand that in June of this year, the NRC began laying the groundwork to sell low level radioactive soil from nuclear power plants and other NRC-licensed facilities.

Once these materials enter the marketplace, they cannot be reclaimed. The release of these materials for commercial use will incalculably increase the health risks to everyone.

Such a policy would be the moral equivalent of the human radiation experiments secretly conducted on unwitting civilian victims during the 1950s and 1960s.

Please don't do it.
