Dear Mr. Collins:

In accordance with the conditions in Section III of the NRC's orders approving the transfer of licenses and conforming amendments (References 1 and 2) the New York Power Authority (NYPA) and Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (ENO) submit:

- Documentary evidence of insurance required under 10 CFR 140;
- Decommissioning funding assurance, and
- Notice of closing date for sale and transfer of Indian Point 3 and FitzPatrick.

Evidence of Insurance - Section III.(1)

Evidence of insurance required under 10 CFR 140 was submitted to the USNRC in References 3 and 4. American Nuclear Insurers (ANI) notified the USNRC that ANI will write nuclear liability insurance for Entergy Nuclear FitzPatrick, LLC, (ENF) and ENO covering the James A. FitzPatrick Nuclear Power Plant and for Entergy Nuclear Indian Point 3, LLC (ENIP3) and ENO covering the Indian Point Generating Unit No. 3. As stated in those letters, the insurance will be effective coincident with the acquisitions of these stations from the Power Authority of the State of New York. These letters go on to state that this insurance is being purchased to satisfy the requirements for primary and secondary financial protection as set forth in Section 170b of the Atomic Energy Action of 1954, as amended.

Decommissioning Funding - Section III.(2)

Audited amounts for the decommissioning fund for Indian Point 3 and FitzPatrick as of September 30, 2000, are:

Indian Point 3	-	\$315,225,000
FitzPatrick	-	\$343,968,000


These amounts exceed those required under NRC regulations in 10 CFR 50.75.

Notice of Closing Date - Section III.(17)

The necessary regulatory approvals have been received and NYPA will sell and transfer the Indian Point 3 and FitzPatrick nuclear power plants to ENIP3, ENF and ENO, respectively on Tuesday, November 21, 2000.






