SUBJECT: SECY-92-174 - RESPONSE TO GENERAL ELECTRIC
AND WESTINGHOUSE PETITION FOR RULEMAKING TO
ALLOW SELF GUARANTEE AS AN ADDITIONAL MEANS
FOR COMPLIANCE WITH DECOMMISSIONING
REGULATIONS

The Commission (with all Commissioners agreeing) has disapproved the staff's recommendation to deny the petition. The petition for rulemaking should be granted incorporating the attached changes to 10 CFR Part 30, Appendix B, and including the requirement for annual recertification as stated in paragraph II.B.(4). The revised Federal Register notice should be forwarded for Commission review prior to publication.

In addition, the Federal Register notice should solicit comments on whether the Commission should consider deleting the financial test requirement for a tangible net worth of at least \$1 billion. The final analysis should be included in the final rule package when it is submitted to the Commission for review.
