This memorandum provides the Parties to this proceeding information that is relevant and material to issues pending before the Commission.

The Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR) has issued the attached license amendment that authorizes the licensee for the Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 3 (MNPS3) to increase the capacity of the MNPS3 spent fuel pool from 756 spent fuel assemblies (SFAs) to 1,860 SFAs.

The NRR review covered occupational radiation exposure, storage rack and spent fuel pool structural aspects, rack and neutron absorber material compatibility in the spent fuel pool environment, criticality considerations, control and handling of heavy loads, and thermal-hydraulics considerations.
