Dear Chairman Meserve,


On behalf of the 89 organizations that comprise the UNPLUG Salem Campaign, this letter is a request that the NRC immediately release all the results of its recent inspection of the steam generators at Salem Unit 2 to the public by means of a public meeting at Artificial Island. We request that this meeting be structured so that our experts can ask relevant questions of the inspectors, and that this meeting be recorded and made part of the NRC's public record.

We feel that this action by the NRC is required for several reasons: (1) Because of the similarities in steam generators and alloys between Salem 2 and Indian Point; (2) Because of the recent Inspector General's report of the IP incident which showed laxness on the part of the NRC; (3) To ensure public confidence that the steam generators at Salem 2 are indeed safe; (4) Because UNPLUG Salem has been given confidential information that indicates that the water chemistry at Salem has allowed impurities to be introduced into the steam generator water and that impurities are present in lubrication oil; and (5) To show to the public that the NRC is indeed concerned about safety.

The NRC seems to find the time to put out "dog and pony" shows about your new inspection program. Thus we are sure that NRC can find the time and resources to hold a public meeting at Salem on the issue as to whether or not Salem Unit 2's steam generators are truly safe.

Please reply as soon as possible and inform us when the public meeting will be held.
