This is in response to Duquesne Light Company's (DLC) letter dated October 4, 1995, in which DLC provided clarifying comments regarding our safety evaluation for BVPS-2 License Amendment No. 73 which was issued on August 25, 1995. We have reviewed the clarifications provided in DLC's October 4, 1995 letter; we agree with these clarifications. The clarifications do not change our conclusion regarding the safety of maintaining High Head Safety Injection (HHSI) pump minimum flow valve 2CHS*MOV373 open to provide a minimum flow path for HHSI pumps; therefore, we have determined that it is not necessary to issue a revised safety evaluation.
