**DOCKET 50-255 - LICENSE DPR-20 - PALISADES PLANT
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT
VIOLATION REPORT - MAY 1, 2000 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2000**

Palisades letter dated April 17, 1985 stated that we would submit all National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit violations and reports of oil, salt or polluting material loss on a semi-annual basis within 30 days from April 30 and October 31. This information is submitted in compliance with Sections 3.2 and 5.4.2 of Appendix B of the Palisades Facility Operating License.

This letter is to inform you that during the period from May 1, 2000 through October 31, 2000, no NPDES permit violations were reported to the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality. During the same period, there were no reports of oil, salt, or polluting material losses made to governmental agencies.
