Dear Mr. Scheinman:

Enclosed is a letter from Siemens Power Corporation requesting an amendment to export license XSNM02969 to add the authority to export Canadian-origin source material to Taiwan for use as reload fuel in the Chinshan 1&2 and Kuosheng 1&2 reactors.

Inasmuch as Canada has not pre-approved the retransfer of their material to Taiwan, Betty Wright of my office contacted the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) to inquire about the appropriate procedures for authorizing the transfer. Mr. W.A. Laidlaw advised her that U.S. requests to retransfer Canadian-origin material to Taiwan will have to be reviewed and approved by Canada on a case-by-case basis until CNSC completes their formal arrangements with Taiwan and so notifies the U.S.

Your assistance in obtaining the necessary CNSC authorization on this case will be greatly appreciated.
