SUBJECT: MEETING WITH STRATEGIC TEAMING AND RESOURCE SHARING -  
INTEGRATED REGULATORY AFFAIRS GROUP FOR THE LICENSEES OF  
CALLAWAY, COMANCHE PEAK, DIABLO CANYON, SOUTH TEXAS, AND  
WOLF CREEK

A meeting was held on Thursday, November 9, 2000, between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) staff and the licensees for the above facilities. The meeting was held at the request of the Strategic Teaming and Resource Sharing - Integrated Regulatory Affairs Group (STARS-IRAG) that has been formed by the licensees. The IRAG is a group within STARS organized to interact with the NRC staff on common regulatory issues for the facilities. The notice for the meeting was issued on October 20, 2000. This is the second meeting of the staff with the STARS-IRAG. The meeting summary for the first meeting was issued on September 1, 2000.

A list of the meeting attendees is provided in the attachment, and the licensee's handouts may be viewed in ADAMS under the accession number ML003768242. The NRC staff did not provide a handout at the meeting. There was no discussion of any current licensing actions under staff review for any of the above facilities. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the risk-informed inservice inspections (ISIs) for the facilities; however, the licensees were not prepared to present a draft of the submittals to be made by the individual facilities and these inspections were not discussed. The licensees instead discussed the status of common licensing request submittals from the facilities to be made in the future. The goal of STARS-IRAG is to reduce the overall costs of licensing actions to the licensees and to the staff by developing common licensing action requests.

As discussed above, the licensees provided in their handouts, a draft copy of (1) a monthly licensing actions report to be sent to the NRC project managers for the facilities, and (2) a submittal for one of the common licensing actions being considered by the STARS-IRAG. As shown in the draft monthly report, future monthly reports on the facilities would contain a table of common licensing actions under development for the facilities. One of the common licensing actions is the subject of the draft submittal in the licensees' handout. The draft submittal was discussed to show what information would be submitted in a plant-specific submittal. One of

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the items of information would be an attachment showing the STARS joint licensing action request (LAR) comparison table. This is Attachment 5 in the draft submittal.

The licensees' schedule to submit applications for applying risk-informed ISI at the facilities has been delayed to February 15, 2001. The licensees stated that they will request a coordination meeting sometime before the submittal date to allow STARS-IRAG to explain what will be submitted for each facility.

The licensees completed their presentation and the meeting was closed.
