Dear Mr. Lundvall:

In response to the Commission's Show Cause Order issued on January 2, 1980, your submittals dated January 22 and 30, 1980 provided documentation indicating that completion of some of the Category A requirements for the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Units Nos. 1 and 2 necessitates equipment which is expected to become available on the following schedule:

2.1.3b	February 18, 1980
2.1.4	February 6, 1980

After reviewing this matter, we conclude that you have shown that necessary equipment will not be available for implementation by January 31, 1980. For those items the implementation schedule of within 30 days of receipt of the equipment but no later than June 1, 1980, as specified in the Order, is appropriate.

As indicated in our letter dated October 30, 1979 the acceptability of your implementation of each Category A item (excluding 2.1.7a) will be the subject of post implementation review. Should your information concerning the availability of the equipment change, notify this office within five days of receipt of the new information.
