MEMORANDUM AND ORDER
(Supplemental Filing Schedules and Procedures)

By Memorandum and Order (Filing Schedules and Procedures), dated November 30, 2000, LBP-00-32, the Presiding Officer in this license-transfer proceeding under 10 C.F.R. Part 2, Subpart M, set forth filing schedules and procedures for parties to follow in implementing the schedules and procedures outlined by the Commission in CLI-00-22.

Reflecting the circumstance set forth in CLI-00-22 that the NRC Staff is not a party to the proceeding, LBP-00-32 did not set forth any schedules or procedures for the NRC Staff to follow. Nonetheless, CLI-00-22 provided for the Staff to provide its Safety Evaluation Report (SER) of the license transfer to the parties, as well as the Presiding Officer, and to present such report at the oral hearing, should one be held.

On December 4, 2000, the Presiding Officer was telephoned by Steven Hom, Esq., counsel for the NRC Staff, who asked for his name to be substituted on the service list in place of Lawrence J. Chandler, Esq., Office of the General Counsel. The following name should be

included on the service list:

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In addition, the Presiding Officer requested Mr. Hom, who will represent the Staff in presenting the SER at an oral hearing if one be held, to file by 11:59 p.m. on December 7, 2000 (the same date fixed for other parties) a Notice of Appearance, modified to reflect the Staff's non-party status.

Mr. Hom further advised that the SER has already been provided to all parties and that he would send one in the near future to the Presiding Officer (together with the Staff's Order granting the requested license changes). Parties should note that their written responses to direct and rebuttal testimony and proposed questions, which are scheduled to be filed by 11:59 p.m. on January 16, 2001, should include responses and questions relating to information set forth in the SER. By that same date, the Staff should identify any sponsoring witness or witnesses it plans to use in presenting the SER at the February 2, 2001 oral hearing (see CLI-00-22, slip op. at 57).
